

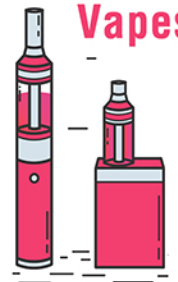
# TUOLUMNE COUNTY Rx TAKE-BACK DAY

Drop off all prescribed and over the counter medication except for intravenous solutions, injectables, and syringes. Liquid products, such as cough syrup, should remain sealed in their original container. Remove medications from their containers prior to disposal. All participants will remain anonymous and no record of dropped off medications will be maintained. A Tuolumne County Sheriff's Deputy will be on scene to provide security for the participants and for the controlled substances.



The Tuolumne County Sheriff's Department, YES Partnership and the DEA are providing a safe and confidential way for members of our community to rid their homes of unused or expired medication.
